

PUBLIC NOTICE & PUBLIC HEARING

CITY OF FARMINGTON COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG) 2020 Action Plan – 3rd Substantial Amendment

The City of Farmington proposes to amend the 2020 Action Plan by **reallocating \$23,935.29 that was designated to a 2018 Capital Improvement project to a 2020 Capital Improvement project**. Pursuant to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) regulations and the City of Farmington Citizen Participation Plan adopted in 2019, these changes are considered a “Substantial Amendment” to the **2020 Action Plan** that require specific citizen participation action before the change may be approved by the City Council and submitted to HUD.

PROPOSED 3rd SUBSTANTIAL AMENDMENT TO THE 2020 ACTION PLAN

This amendment is to reallocate funds from a reduced capital project listed in the 2018 Action Plan, to a 2020 capital project that had partial funding retracted by HUD:

2020 Annual Action Plan approved on October 13, 2020: Capital Project

- Proposed Amendment to the 2020 Community Development Block Grant to reallocate a \$23,935.29 balance from the Dallas Senior Center ADA Improvements to the Animas District ADA Improvements project.

PUBLIC REVIEW/COMMENT

The 3rd Substantial Amendment to the **2020 Action Plan** will be available for public review and comment beginning March 11, 2022. The draft amendment will be available from the City of Farmington’s CDBG website, as well as at the City Clerk’s office, the Community Development Department, the Reference Section of the Farmington Public Library, Sycamore Park Community Center, the Farmington Indian Center, the Bonnie Dallas Senior Center, and the San Juan Center for Independence. Comments on the draft amendment will be accepted through the public hearing which is scheduled during the City Council Meeting on Tuesday, April 12, 2022. Consideration of the amendment adoption of the 2020 Annual Action Plan by resolution of the City Council is scheduled at the same meeting after the public hearing.
